



**Here's a basic wedding checklist to help you stay organized:**

<b>12+ Months Before the Wedding</b>	
Set a Budget: Determine how much you're willing to spend.	
Choose a Date and Venue: Decide on the wedding date and book your venue.	
Create a Guest List: Start drafting your guest list.	
Hire a Wedding Planner (optional): If you need help organizing.	
Book Key Vendors: Photographer, videographer, caterer, and entertainment.	
Choose Wedding Party: Select your bridesmaids, groomsmen, etc.	
<b>9-12 Months Before the Wedding</b>	
Send Save-the-Dates: Let your guests know the date.	
Buy Wedding Dress: Start shopping for your dress and schedule fittings.	
Reserve Accommodations: Block hotel rooms for out-of-town guests.	
Register for Gifts: Set up a wedding registry.	
Plan Engagement Party: If you're having one.	
<b>6-9 Months Before the Wedding</b>	
Hire Florist: Book a florist for your floral arrangements.	
Plan Honeymoon: Decide on your destination and book accommodations.	
Choose Attire: Select outfits for the bridal party.	
Order Invitations: Design and order wedding invitations.	
Book Transportation: Arrange for transportation on the wedding day.	
<b>3-6 Months Before the Wedding</b>	
Send Invitations: Mail out your wedding invitations.	
Plan Ceremony: Meet with your officiant and finalize the ceremony details.	
Book Hair and Makeup: Schedule trials and book stylists.	
Order Wedding Cake: Choose a baker and design your cake.	
Plan Reception Details: Finalize menu, seating, and decor.	
<b>1-3 Months Before the Wedding</b>	
Apply for Marriage License: Check the requirements and apply.	
Create a Day-of Timeline: Plan out the wedding day schedule.	
Confirm Details with Vendors: Double-check all arrangements.	
Order Favors: Purchase or make wedding favors.	
Write Vows (if personal): Prepare what you'll say during the ceremony.	
<b>1-2 Weeks Before the Wedding</b>	
Final Dress Fitting: Ensure your dress fits perfectly.	
Create Seating Chart: Finalize where guests will sit.	
Pack for Honeymoon: Get your travel essentials ready.	
Check in with Vendors: Confirm all last-minute details.	
Plan Rehearsal Dinner: Organize and confirm the rehearsal and dinner.
